- Team/Staff Update

 - Highlights

 - Scheduled for outdoor pool concessions
 - Bids are out for Willow Creek pool to be redone
 - Bids are out for Silver Lake pool

Swim Lessons: Ashleigh Kramer

- Summer registration: going well - almost full!
- Pricing/policy update: 9/1/25 private lessons will shift from \$35/private and \$55/semi-private → \$40/private and \$60/semi-private.
With shift to monthly programming, registration adjustment fee will

drop from \$25 to \$20 allowing congruency across all lesson types and lower percentage of total paid per "session".
